

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - PIXELS 2019

1	Entrants will be recognised photographic clubs, societies or similar and affiliated to either the Welsh Photographic Federation or the North Wales Photographic Association .
2	Each club shall enter 4 images, each being the work of a different photographer. Images must not have been entered into any previous Pixels competition and photographers must own the copyright of their entry and be able to assert their moral right to be associated with <u>all</u> aspects of the source elements. There is no set theme. Please note, a photographer may represent <u>only one club</u>.
3	There will be an entry fee of £10.00 (cheques to be payable to Gwynfa Camera Club) .
4	Entry Size - Each digital photograph must conform to the following file specifications: a) Maximum Width: 1920 pixels b) Maximum Height: 1080 pixels c) File Type: JPEG only d) Resolution: Anything from 72ppi to 300ppi is acceptable. Note: As we will be projecting at 100%, lesser file sizes will appear smaller on screen. For example, 1024x768 will appear considerably smaller. 1400x1050 just a little smaller.
5	Submission of entries. There are three alternatives:- <u>Entry by email</u> Please send entries (and a scan of your completed entry form) to leigh@coform.com Important: If you can't scan the entry form your email should contain the image titles, photographer's names and any preferred projection order. Your entry fee should arrive within one week of us receiving your entry email. We regret that entry fees cannot be accepted on the day of the competition. <u>Entry by post</u> Please send your entry form, CDR or USB and entry fee to: Leigh Woolford, 9 Pantygraigwen Road, Pontypridd, CF37 2RR. USB sticks should be clearly marked with your club name and collected at the event. <u>Delivery personally</u> Please contact Leigh Woolford to arrange a time. (Email: leigh@coform.com or phone 01443 491333 or 07800 878782).
6	The judge will not be affiliated to any club in the WPF or NWPA and will be asked to assess entries using a properly calibrated computer monitor.
7	The ' Gwynfa Pixels Trophy ' will be presented to the club achieving the highest aggregate score. In the event of a tie , the winning club will be determined by highest number of 20s, 19s, 18s etc. Awards will also be made for the entries deemed by the judge to be ' Best Monochrome ' and ' Best Colour ' photographs. Trophies do not need to be returned.
8	Gwynfa CC reserves the right to use 'Pixels' entries for publicity and/or for circulating as a portfolio presentation. Entries originating from WPF clubs may also be passed on to the WPF for use in inter-federation events. In such cases the photographer will be duly credited.
9	Submission of an entry implies acceptance of the above conditions.
